

**EXCERPT FROM THE STATUTE
OF SERBIAN TURKISH FRIENDSHIP ASSOCIATION OF CITIZENS –INAT**

Article 1.

The Association of citizens INAT (International Nongovernment Association for Toleranc) was constituted as a non-party,non-government and non-profit association of citizens with the purpose of developing mutural friendship within the Serbian Turkish community,cherishing well-neighborbty relationships,scientific research of ethnologic matter,protection of cultural and historical monuments of both nations in this region,preserving tradition,protection of ecological and human rights in general,as well as stimulating cooperation between the two nations,both individually and through social,political and economical institutions in the fields of economic and national affirmation in the world.

Article 2.

For the purpose of its objectives,the Association particularly:

- 1) Collect and study scientific and professional literature,national heritage related to life and development of Serbian and Turkish entites in this region.**
 - 2) Organize individually or together with other organizations,professional gatherings,counsels,seminars,memorials ofimportant events and other activities within this framework.**
 - 3) Publish books and other editions within its field of interest,and in accordance with the law.**
 - 4) Co-ordinate scientific and professional personnel to work on scientific,professional and research projects concerning ethnological and human rights issues.**
 - 5) Cooperative with universities,professional associations and other organizations-domestic and abroad dealing with Serbian-Turkish history and human rights in general.**

Article 12.

To support its objectives,the Association makes contacts and cooperates with expert,scientific,educational and semnar associations in the country and abroad.

Article 13.

The Association raises faunds from membership fees, donations,bidding projects with government authorities or foundations and from other legel sources.
